Visiting IES

Travel:

Montpellier Méditerranée Airport (MPL) is directly connected to Paris and several national or international airports. To go to the city center, take the airport shuttle (line 120) waiting on the left when exiting the arrival terminal. It will drop you at the "Place de l'Europe" tramway stop. Take tramway line 1 (blue cars) bound to "Mosson" to get to the city center.

Another option is to fly to Marseille (MRS) and then take a train at the nearby train station (a bus shuttle connects MRS to the train station). It takes \sim 1.5 h to reach Montpellier.

Montpellier is also connected to Lyon and Paris via high speed trains. It takes ~3.5 h from Paris' city center (*Gare de Lyon*) and ~4.5 h from Paris-Charles-de-Gaulle Airport's train station to reach Montpellier. Montpellier-Lyon takes ~2 h.

Note: there are 2 train stations in Montpellier: "Montpellier Sud de France" is outside the city. We strongly advise that you travel to "Montpellier-Saint-Roch" station.

Campus St Priest of University of Montpellier

IES is located on Campus St Priest, 860 rue Saint Priest, 34090 Montpellier.

To reach the place from downtown, take the tramway line 1 (blue cars) bound to "Mosson". Get-off at "Château d'O" stop. Walk back along the tramway track for ~200 m. Cross "avenue des Moulins" to the left and enter "rue St Priest". The campus entrance is on your right after ~200 m walk. The meeting room is in the first building when entering the campus (see map).

Alternatively, get-off at "Occitanie" stop and walk along the track for ~500 m. Cross "avenue des Moulins" to the right and enter on the Campus through the pedestrian gateway. The meeting room is in the first building on the left (see map).
